



6 Day / 5 Night – Alaska’s Aurora Borealis

The Aurora Borealis is one of the most spectacular of nature's phenomena, described as flickering curtains of dancing light against dark skies. If you are traveling during fall, and the evening sky is clear, keep an eye out for the Aurora's, commonly referred to as the "Northern Lights". Better yet, plan a more specialized tour to Alaska during winter to observe the lights. The Northern Lights are typically visible throughout the state from about the third week of September through the third week of March. Higher latitudes correspond to a better opportunity for viewing the Aurora's. For this reason, most aurora viewing programs are planned for the Fairbanks area.

Day 1 – Arrive Fairbanks Upon arrival at the Fairbanks International Airport, a private transfer will be provided to your hotel. Overnight Fairbanks

Day 2 – Fairbanks to Chena Hot Springs This morning, travel north of Fairbanks to Chena Hot Springs. You will have unlimited access to the soothing waters of the hot springs with your choice of both indoor and outdoor pools. Soak in the mineral water as you look for the dancing northern lights in the night sky. Later this evening, you will get another aurora viewing opportunity with your Snow Coach Tour. Glide over the snowy trails via Snow Coach to an indoor heated yurt. Spend approximately 1 hour at the yurt before returning to Chena. Your private vehicle will bring you back to Fairbanks. Overnight Fairbanks



Day 3 – Fairbanks Fairbanks is one city in Alaska that manages to get even more beautiful in the winter. Visitors come from all over the world to see the famous Aurora Borealis, commonly known as the Northern Lights. You will have the day free to participate in optional activities or relax. This evening, your private vehicle will take you on an aurora viewing adventure. Overnight Fairbanks

Day 4 – Fairbanks Today you will have the day free to participate in optional activities or relax. Another aurora viewing excursion has been planned for this evening to maximize aurora viewing opportunities. Overnight Fairbanks

Day 5 – Fairbanks No activities have been planned for you today. You will have the day at leisure to participate in optional activities on your own. Overnight Fairbanks

Day 6 – Depart Fairbanks A private transfer will be provided to the Fairbanks International Airport in time to meet your scheduled flight. **End of Services**
