SHAKER VILLAGE TO LEXINGTON



Begin your journey in central Kentucky at the beautifully restored Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill. Here you will find a peaceful and tranquil setting to learn of the spiritual history of this religious order. The village has 3,000 acres and 34 original Shaker structures that house museums, craft workshops, gift shops, overnight accommodations and a dining room.

DAY 1: SHAKER VILLAGE OF PLEASANT HILL

Memory Making Experiences:

Tour the Grounds and Buildings

Tour 34 surviving, historic buildings to learn of the iconic Shaker architecture. Interpreters and exhibits tell the story of the daily life of the Shakers including their worship, work and family life. Live musical performances and other talks happen throughout the day. Visit the working farm to meet the many animals that live and work at the village and enjoy guided and self-guided hikes throughout the pristine 3,000 acre property. All of these activities are included in the price of admission

Take a hay ride

See the beautiful grounds from the back of a horse drawn wagon every weekend from April through October. Extra charges apply.

See Studio Artists at Work

Local artists have studio space at the Village and demonstrate their craft daily.

Ride the Dixie Belle

Take a ride about the Dixie Belle riverboat along the beautiful Kentucky River and see the palisades from April through October. Extra charges apply.

Participate in a Workshop

Learn a craft such a broom making, participate in a paddle yoga class, learn all about sustainable garden-
