- Hotel for check-in and relaxation.
- Enjoy a dinner cruise aboard the <u>Dutch Apple</u> or <u>Captain JP Cruise</u> (seasonal), or a unique Albany restaurant.
- Head to an evening show at <u>Times Union Center</u>, <u>The Egg</u>, <u>Capital</u> Repertory Theatre, Palace Performing Arts Center, Troy Music Hall, Cohoes Music Hall, Comedy Works, or Proctors Theatre, to name a few.
- Return to hotel for overnight.

DAY TWO:

- Breakfast at hotel

- Enjoy nightlife in the Capital-Saratoga region! Take a 40 minute trip north to the <u>Saratoga Casino & Raceway</u>, Saratoga Race Course⁸, or see a Broadway show at <u>Proctors Theatre</u> in Schenectady (20 minutes), or <u>Cohoes Music Hall</u> in Cohoes (just 15 minutes north of Albany).
- Return to hotel for overnight.

- Check out of hotel and enjoy breakfast.
- Before departing from the Albany area, shop at one of our diverse malls, (Colonie Center Mall, Stuyvesant Plaza, Crossgates Mall, etc.) or unique shops, plus stop at the only Christmas Tree Shops in the region!
