## Taste of the Lower Eastern Shore of VA

### Morning

#### **Eastern Shore of Virginia National Wildlife Refuge**

- Visitor Center – exhibits, displays, videos
- Nature Trails
- WW 2 Bunker
  - Large gun from USS Missouri (16" bore, 68' long, 125 tons)
  - Overlook

#### **Eyre Hall Gardens**

- Private residence, gardens open to the public
- Among the oldest in the country, circa 1800

### Lunch

#### **Eastville Inn**

- Historic Inn and Coach House
- Museum displays

### Afternoon

#### **Eastville Courthouse Green & Buildings**

- Declaration of Independence read on this green in August 1776
- The old Courthouse, Clerk's Office, and Prison form a remarkable assemblage of early Virginia Court buildings. The Clerk's Office contains country's oldest court and land records, dating from 1632.

#### **Cape Charles**

- Historic (1884) railroad town
- One of the largest concentration of Victorian homes on the East coast
- Two signature golf courses – Jack Nicklaus and Arnold Palmer
- Harbor, marina
- Public beach, fishing pier
- Art galleries and gift / boutique / gourmet shops
