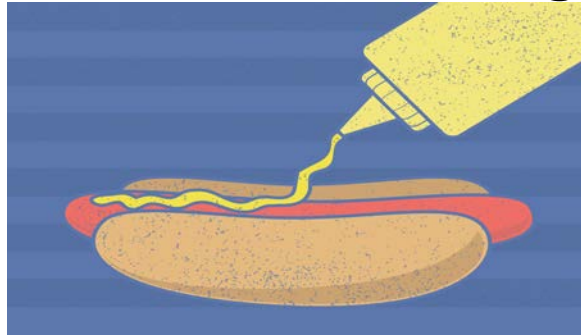


# Lunch Counter Lingo
