



9 Day / 8 Night – Alaskan Active Adventure

Day 1 – Arrive Anchorage Upon arrival at the Ted Stevens International Airport, you will have a private transfer to your hotel. Overnight Anchorage

Day 2 – Anchorage to Seward Board your private vehicle for your journey to Seward. In Seward, you will get to experience a mixture of back-country and on-trail trekking on your hike to Exit Glacier.



This 5-hour tour will travel over 1.5 miles creating the perfect experience for outdoor enthusiasts. You will spend approximately 1 hour on the ice exploring Exit Glacier. Overnight Seward

Day 3 – Seward Today you will explore the spectacular beauty of Resurrection Bay with a fun and adventuresome paddle trip. Come face to face with sea otters and other marine life as you paddle in your two person kayak along the shoreline of Lowell Point State Recreation Area. Overnight Seward

Day 4 – Seward to Talkeetna Your private motorcoach will meet you at your hotel today for your journey to Talkeetna. Today's drive will take you on the Seward Highway and along Turnagain Arm. This stretch of road is designated as an All-American Road, and considered one of the most scenic drives in the United States. From jagged peaks and alpine meadows to breathtaking fjords and crystal lakes, you will find a concentrated series of diverse landscapes and experiences. Overnight Talkeetna

Day 5 – Talkeetna This small, distinctive community offers the best views of Denali and the Alaska Range. The area provides visitors the chance to take a flightseeing tour around Denali, go salmon fishing, enjoy a guided hike, or go on a jetboat adventure. Today's zip line adventure will begin at the forested ridges above Talkeetna and the Susitna River Valley. Traverse from one platform to the next via nine zip rides, three suspension bridges, a spiral staircase, and a rappel through the boreal forest. Overnight Talkeetna

Day 6 – Talkeetna to Denali This morning, you will travel to Denali by private vehicle. At 6 million acres, Denali National Park is one of the world's last great frontiers for wilderness adventure. Upon arrival at the park entrance, you will suit up for an exciting rafting trip. You can choose to paddle as a team or let the guide handle the oars. Enjoy every minute of your journey as you head for Healy, 11 miles downriver. Get into real whitewater rafting as you hang on through thrilling rapids such as "Cable Car", "Coffee Grinder", and "Ice Worm"! Rapids are mostly Class III, with one Class IV. Overnight Denali National Park Entrance



Day 7 – Denali; Denali National Park Denali National Park lies in the heart of the 600 mile long Alaska Range. The center of the Alaska Range has a number of peaks over 10,000 feet in elevation which include Denali, the highest peak in North America. Your shuttle bus will travel approximately 66 miles deep into the park, offering outstanding views of Denali and the Alaska Range, plus wildlife viewing opportunities. Stop at the Eielson Visitor Center, where you can take a hike on your own around the trails, or join National Park Service Rangers for daily guided walks before catching a return shuttle to the park entrance. Overnight Denali National Park Entrance

Day 8 – Denali to Anchorage Begin your return journey south with your private motorcoach. During the drive, you will be surrounded by three of Alaska’s major mountain chains: the Alaska and Talkeetna ranges, and the Chugach Mountains. Approaching Anchorage you will pass by the residential community of Eagle River, and the military installation in Anchorage. Overnight Anchorage

Day 9 – Depart Anchorage A private transfer will be provided to the Anchorage International Airport in time to meet your scheduled flight.
