

8 Day / 7 Night - Best of Alaska

Day 1 – Arrive Anchorage Upon arrival at the Ted Stevens International Airport, you will have a private transfer to your hotel. Overnight Anchorage

Day 2 – Anchorage to Seward Travel aboard the Alaska Railroad Coastal Classic train to Seward. Upon arrival in Seward, you will have the day at your leisure to explore the 'gateway to Kenai Fjords National Park.' Overnight Seward

Day 3 – Seward; Kenai Fjords National Park Today you will embark on a 6-hour wildlife cruise into Kenai Fjords National Park. Experience miles of beautiful fjords and coastal landscape while your captain looks for marine animals such as orca (killer) whales, humpback whales, Stellar sea lions, harbor seals, sea otters, puffins,



etc. Following your cruise, you will have the remainder of the day at leisure. Overnight Seward

Day 4 – Seward to Talkeetna Your private vehicle will meet you at your hotel today for your journey to Talkeetna. Today's drive will take you on the Seward Highway and along Turnagain Arm. This stretch of road is designated as an All-American Road, and considered one of the most scenic drives in the United States. From jagged peaks and alpine meadows to breathtaking fjords and crystal lakes, you will find a concentrated series of diverse landscapes and experiences. Overnight Talkeetna

Day 5 – Talkeetna to Denali This morning, board the Denali Star train to Denali. Leaving Talkeetna, the train will take you into the Alaska Range where you will have views of mountains, glaciers, rivers, and canyons. The remainder of the ride to Denali is considered the most scenic, passing through the former site of the Curry Hotel and over incredible Hurricane Gulch, all the while in the shadow of Denali. Overnight Denali National Park Entrance



Day 6 – Denali; Denali National Park Denali National Park lies in the heart of the 600 mile long Alaska Range. The center of the Alaska Range has a number of peaks over 10,000 feet in elevation which include Denali, the highest peak in North America. At 20,320 feet, Denali stands as the focal point of the park. Traveling deep into the park to the Teklanika or Toklat River rest areas, the Tundra Wilderness Tour offers a sub-arctic experience like no other. You'll have the opportunity to witness incredible scenery, a narrated history of Denali National Park and some of the best opportunities to view and photograph the park's wildlife such

as; Dall sheep, moose, caribou, wolves and grizzly bears. When Denali is visible, it may be possible to

travel to Stony Hill Overlook and view the entire mountain from base to summit. Overnight Denali National Park Entrance

Day 7 – **Denali to Anchorage** Begin your return journey south with your private vehicle. During your drive you will pass through the Matanuska-Susitna Valley, which is considered one of the most important agriculture areas in Alaska. During your drive you will be surrounded by three of Alaska's major mountain chains: the Alaska and Talkeetna ranges, and the Chugach Mountains. Approaching Anchorage you will pass by the residential community of Eagle River, and the military installation in Anchorage: Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER). Overnight Anchorage

Day 8 – Depart Anchorage A private transfer will be provided to the Anchorage International Airport in time to meet your scheduled flight.
