

Whose Story is It?

This icebreaker will have your travelers guessing whose off-the-wall, but true stories are whose.

Materials:

Pens
Glass bowl or other container

Paper
Four Chairs

Instructions:

Pass out slips of paper and pens. Have everyone briefly write down a true story or experience that happened to them on the paper along with their name. The more bizarre, the better.

Fold the slips of paper and put them into the container, shuffling them and mixing them up.

Picks out four slips of paper and calls out the names of the people. Have this group sit apart from the rest of the participants where they can be seen, by the group leader works great.

Read out each of the four stories then have the rest of the group try to guess whose story is whose by asking different people to tell the stories.

The people on the couch try to convince the group that the story they tell really is theirs. After everyone on the couch has told a few different stories, the group votes.

This repeats until all of the travelers have shared a story.
