Her people are resourceful, spiritual, and the guardians of the diverse cultures who settled here - African, French, German, Italian, and Spanish.

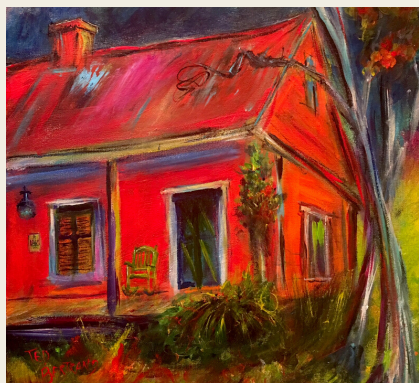
St. Landry Parish is proud to have six Cultural Districts: Deux Bayous – Arnaudville, Eunice, Grand Coteau, Opelousas, Sunset, and Washington. In these designations, sales of original artwork are exempt from local sales tax.

IT'S ALL ABOUT LOCATION

St. Landry Parish is conveniently situated between Alexandria and Lafayette, LA. Our parish seat, Opelousas, Louisiana, is located at the intersections of Interstate 49 and Highway 190 which leads to the Louisiana state capital, Baton Rouge. Also, keep in mind that St. Landry Parish is only 2 hours west of New Orleans and 20 minutes North of Interstate 10.
